

## Middle School Math & Science Teacher

Forest Grove Community School is a small charter school (204 students in grades 1 through 8). Our school uses a place-based pedagogical approach and is structured around the three principles of scholarship, stewardship, and citizenship. While academic standards for our students are the same as those of other public schools, instruction here emphasizes subject-matter integration and experiential learning. Our middle school program has a culture of personal connection, inclusion, and high expectations.

Teacher applicants must either:

- + Hold a current Oregon teacher license with endorsements that authorize them to teach 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade math and science.
- + Meet charter school registration requirements through which applicants demonstrate content knowledge in math and science.

Along with typical teaching responsibilities, this position requires an individual able to:

- Help plan and lead weekly curriculum-based field trips (called “Out and Abouts”);
- Teach social-emotional curriculum and support student growth in this area.

Special consideration will be given to applicants who have the following: Three years’ experience teaching; experience working in a place-based or project-based school; experience working with children in 7th and 8th grades; ESOL credentials.
